

Strong Interest Inventory

The Interest Inventory workshop credit is ideal to help sophomore Scholars think about their major and/or career interests in conjunction with the Meyers-Briggs discussed in Management Concepts and to help juniors think about their interests for the internship. The Scholar works with the Career Center to take and discuss the Strong Interest Inventory (“SII”). The SII measures your interests and helps you to identify career options and possible majors that would match you well. The Career Center will inform the Business Scholars Program staff when you have completed the following:

- Have brief meeting with the Career Center prior to taking the SII.
- Take the SII online.
- Meet with the Career Center to discuss the implications for your major and/or career.
